Mark 14:12-25

- I. Passover preparations. (12-16)
 - Lasted for <u>7</u> days.
 - Recalled their <u>deliverance</u>.
 - First night was the Passover meal.
 - In <u>Jerusalem</u>.

Unleavened bread MENU Wine in four cups Bitter herbs A sauce of dry fruit and spices A roasted lamb

- Question: Why is this night <u>different</u> from all other nights?
- Key word: <u>Remember</u>.
- Sing & read Psalms 113-118

II. Bitter betrayal. (18-21)

- Jesus tells them so.
- They all <u>deny</u> it.
- Key word: <u>Bittersweet</u>.
- Symbolic of <u>Jesus'</u> suffering.
- Fulfillment of Psalm 41:9

III. Sacrificial supper. (22-26)

- Jesus spoke Aramaic
- He took the bread (<u>body</u>)
- He took the wine (<u>blood</u>)
- Key word: <u>Salvation</u>
- Hebrews 10:11-12

Exodus 6:6-7

- Cup 1. Therefore, say to the Israelites I am the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians.
- Cup 2. I will free you from being slaves to them.
- Cup 3. I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts of judgment.
- Cup 4. I will take you as my own people and I will be your God.

So the four cups are in correspondence to these four promises.
