## **EXODUS TO THE PROMISED LAND** (#6 OF 18) (Exodus to Joshua)

- I. God <u>Raises</u> a Deliverer: Moses is <u>Called</u>. Ex. 1:6-14
  - A. God uniquely saves a baby. Ex. 2:5-10
  - B. God uniquely uses a burning bush. Ex. 3:1-6

God has 1000 ways to call you.

- II. God Redeems His People: Moses Confronts.
  - A. God hears the <u>cries</u> of His people. Ex. 3:7-10 Moses was <u>80</u> years old.
    - 40 in the palace
    - 40 in the pasture
    - 40 as a prophet
  - B. God provides salvation through blood. Ex. 12:1-13
    - 10 Plagues
    - Blood of the Lamb protects from judgment.

Foreshadows the blood of <u>Jesus</u>. Eph. 1:7

## III. God Reveals His Covenant – Moses Commands. Exodus 20ff

- A. 613 Commandments: Civil, ceremonial and moral laws
- B. Summed up: Love God.

Love people. Mt. 22:36-40

All are guardrails guiding us to Jesus. So the law was our guardian until Christ came that we might be justified by faith. Galatians 3:24

## IV. God Reminds Us of His Promises – Moses Concludes.

- A. Promised Land is reached.
  - Moses saw it with his eyes not with his <u>feet</u>.
  - Joshua's book is the story of conquest.
- B. Perfect lesson.
  - Jesus alone brings us to an eternal Promised Land.
  - Moses and the snake.
    - Numbers 21:4-9
    - John 3:14-16
