ADDRESSING THE ROMANS (#15 of 18)

AD 49: Emperor Claudius expelled <u>Jews</u> from Rome for disturbances over "Chrestus."

AD 50: Claudius dies.

AD 56/57: Paul writes Romans.

I. Ruin: Humanity is Ruined by Sin. (1-3)

 Until we see our <u>ruin</u>, we will never run to our <u>Redeemer</u>.

Cf. Romans 1:18-32 Romans 2:8, 9 Romans 3:10-23

II. <u>Rescue</u>: God Steps in to <u>Rescue</u> Us. (<u>Savior</u>) (3-5)

- Justified: Just as if I had <u>never</u> sinned.
- Your greatest problem (<u>sin</u>) has the greatest solution (<u>Jesus</u>).

Cf. Romans 5:1-18

III. <u>Renewal</u>: Everything <u>Changes</u> by the <u>Spirit of God</u>. (6-8)

Jesus rescues you from sin's <u>penalty</u>.
 The Spirit rescues you from sin's <u>power</u>.

Cf. Romans 7:18-25 Romans 8:5-11

IV. <u>Responsibility</u>: All Christians are to <u>Shine</u> in their Faith. (12-16)

- Romans 12–16 is God handing you a <u>jersey</u> and saying, "You are on my <u>team</u>."
- The world doesn't read <u>Romans</u> it reads <u>you</u>.
 Cf. Romans 6:1-7
